Jeff Durham was the Lakota East Upbeat Club President at the time of his sudden death in January 2005. For many Upbeat Club members, Jeff Durham exemplified the best qualities of leadership, musicianship, and friendship. The Lakota East Upbeat Club is proud to remember Jeff Durham's legacy of excellence with this namesake scholarship.

The Lakota East Upbeat Club awards two \$500 Jeff Durham Memorial Scholarships per year to qualifying Seniors at the Lakota East High School Senior Awards Night. Scholarship recipients will also be recognized at the Lakota East High School Band Awards Night. The Jeff Durham Scholarship Selection Committee will select recipients based on the following criteria:

- Graduating Senior
- Senior intends to continue education
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Excels in instrumental music
- Member of Symphonic Band/Symphonic Winds, plus at least one other band (Jazz Band, Marching Band, Honor Band, etc.)
- Demonstrates leadership qualities
- Intends to pursue a band related activity, whether in a college band program and/or a community band program
